Focus – KCC announce the funding to tackle fly-tipping with an additional £250,000 to crack down on fly tipping, an anti – social crime often carried out by criminal gangs. KCC will be charging a modest fee for the disposal of soil, rubble, hardcore and plasterboard at all 18 Household Waste Recycling Centres. They are not sure what the response might be from criminal gangs. However, KCC will be launching a campaign for additional enforcement with the money being made available to the Kent Environmental Crime Waste Practitioner's Group which includes Kent Police, EA and Local Authorities.
